1 Sign on and Sign Off

- 1.1 Each competitor shall sign on as instructed at the Competitors Briefing.
- 1.2 Competitors shall sign off within 15 minutes of coming ashore.
- 1.3 Failing to sign off may result in a DNE score without a hearing unless the Sailing Committee decides otherwise. This changes rule A5.
- 1.4 A boat retiring shall inform the race committee or umpires as soon as possible.




2 Notices to Competitors

- 2.1 Will be posted on the board located at the NLSC and described at the briefing.
- 2.2 Competitor briefings will be held at NLSC.

3 Changes to the Sailing Instructions

- 3.1 Any change made afloat will be identified by the display of International Code Flag 3rd Substitute  with three sound signals. The change will be advised verbally.
- 3.2 Any change made ashore will be identified by the display of International Code Flag L  with 1 sound at least 30 minutes prior to any race affected.

4 Class Flags













- 4.1 Gold Fleet – Gold flag with Open Skiff logo 
- Silver Fleet – Silver flag with Open Skiff logo 
- Green Fleet – Green flag with Open Skiff logo 
- 4.2 Any signal displayed above these flags applies to that fleet only.

5 Start / Finish and Marks

- 5.1 The start line is between the orange flag on the race committee boat at the starboard end and a mark flying an orange flag at the port end.
- 5.2 The finish line will be the same as the start line.
- 5.3 Course marks will fly yellow flags.

6 Start Sequence – amends rule 26

Pointscore races will be started separately for each fleet.

3 minutes to start "Warning Signal"	 or  or   with one sound
2 minutes to start "Preparatory Signal"	  with one sound
1 minute to start	  with one sound
Start	 or  or   with one sound

NOTE: Starting Penalties under rule 30, ie: I, Z, Black and U may still be made in conjunction with the 2 minute signal

NOTE: The Orange flag on the start boat may be raised with one sound signal before the first start sequence to alert boats.

7 Courses

Will be a mixture of windward/leeward, trapezoidal and slalom and will be outlined at the daily briefing.

8 Rules – refer NoR 1

The SI's shall take precedence over the NoR if there is any conflict. Changes rule 63.7

9 Race Areas

Refer to NoR 5.

10 Scoring – refer NoR 7.

A number of novelty type races may be conducted.
These will not count towards a boat's series score.

11 Eligibility – refer NoR 2.

12 Prizes – refer NoR 12

Prizes for novelty type races may be awarded by the OA.
